- Parent Education evening meeting on Kids & Technology

## PRINCIPAL REPORT

**Amii Pratt**, Principal

1. We are “moving and shaking” in June
2. 2018-19 Back to school night
  - a. will be renamed Parent Information Night
  - b. Proposed date Wednesday, September 12th
  - c. Will be only one night instead of two with time slots for grades
  - d. Preferred by staff and parents
3. Next year planning (enrollment, space, specialist scheduling)
  - a. A lot of back and forth decisions
  - b. Decision are line by line, student by student, family by family
  - c. All swing families will be updated by August
  - d. Online registration is available on Skyward now
  - e. BISD is committed to 18-20 classroom sizes in K-3
4. Discussion on whether new schools being built are also able to accommodate growing classroom requirements
  - a. Once Blakely is open, it will receive one of Wilkes’ classrooms
  - b. Each year there are “bubbles” and “indents” in class enrollment
  - c. Off-island kids are rarely accepted into elementary schools on BI
  - d. Amii says “keep asking questions”
